UPPER POTTS GROVE TOWNSHIP RECREATION BOARD REGULATED DEER HUNT 2017

The Upper Pottsgrove Township Recreation Board in cooperation with the Pennsylvania Game Commission will conduct a regulated **archery hunt** between September 17, 2017 and January 28, 2018 inclusive.

Persons interested in receiving a permit to participate in the regulated hunt should be aware of the following:

1. Applications will be accepted only from persons possessing a current Pennsylvania Hunting License and a Wildlife Management Unit 5 CM Antlerless License.

2. **All laws, regulations, and special hunt conditions of the Pennsylvania Game Commission and the Upper Pottsgrove Township Recreation Board are applicable.**

3. Participants must display hunt permit in their vehicle and on their person while hunting.

4. Twenty-four (24) permits total - three (3) per session will be issued for the season.

5. Hunters will pick up their permits at the Upper Pottsgrove Township Municipal Complex. All licenses must be presented at that time.

6. All bow and arrow equipment designated for use in Wildlife Management Unit 5C by the Pennsylvania Game Commission is permissible.

7. **Portable tree stands are permitted in the recreation area. Any stands left after the hunt will be confiscated by the township.**

8. Vehicles of hunters must be parked in designated parking areas.
