- No batteries, cardboard, plastic, or metal, other than staples and paper clips, should be included in the documents.
- Bring documents in boxes or paper bags, no plastic bags.
- 2 boxes or paper bags per vehicle limit in consideration of other attendees.
- Volunteers will assist with removing documents from vehicles.
- This event is open to residents of Montgomery County as a community service. No businesses.
- Capacity is limited and the event must close when trucks are full.

Shred One regularly participates in community shredding events which are sponsored by organizations and governmental agencies. This offers residents the opportunity to destroy their confidential documents and avoid the pitfalls of identity theft. Mobile shredding trucks perform all of the paper shredding on site. All shredded paper is recycled. Shred One is currently recycling paper at a rate which saves over 70,000 trees annually!
