Did you know that PA dog license fees have not increased since 1996?

In that same time...

- ✉ Postage increased by 72%
- 🍞 A loaf of bread increased by 114%
- 🥛 A gallon of milk increased by 182%
- 🚗 A gallon of gas increased by 133%

The Bureau of Dog Law Enforcement will run out of funds to operate in September. Their work protects all Pennsylvanians – both humans and the four-legged and furry.
