CUL-DE-SAC PARKING PROHIBITED DURING A SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY

In order to improve public safety and protect personal property during a snow and ice emergency, the Township will be enforcing a new regulation restricting parking in our township's cul-de-sacs. Our Public Works vehicles have a very difficult time efficiently clearing snow from cul-de-sac bulbs, especially if they are obstructed with parked vehicles or trailers. Therefore, any time our crews are called out to clear snow and ice from our roadways, residents will be required to remove their vehicles from cul-de-sacs for the duration of such snow emergencies. During declared emergencies, no vehicle will be permitted to park within the bulb of the culde-sac or within 25 feet of the entrance to the bulb. Thank you for helping us make a better job of clearing snow from our streets.

Resources page at http://ppl.mclinc.org/index.php/electronic-resources. Librarians are always ready to assist you in getting started using these new technologies, so call if you have any questions.

The library also has DVD and Video Game rentals. Get the latest and greatest titles at a very reasonable rate.

If there is ever a time you cannot find the item you are looking for (whether book, movie or CD), the library staff will be happy to help you locate it through the Interlibrary Loan Service.

Come in to use the library's high speed WiFi connection. Plug in your laptop or other compatible device, and charge up while you do business on the web.

If you do not have your own laptop or compatible device, the library has public Internet computers for general use, and two dedicated workstations for job search, resume building, and career development. The library reference team is always ready to help guide you through these processes, so do not hesitate to ask for assistance.

Once you are online in the library, or on the library website, your library card gives you access to a wide array of periodicals including The Mercury, The Philadelphia Inquirer, and Newsweek Magazine, to name a few. Each with NO ADVERTISEMENTS! You could conceivably read each of these publications before the hard copies even hit the doorstep, as they are basically published instantaneously.

If you are interested in your family history and want to explore a bit, come into the library to access Ancestry.com. You may have heard of this amazing resource already, but if not you will be delighted by how easy it is to use, and how fruitful a quick search session can be! Do not miss out on knowing your past. The reference team is always excited to share their search tips and help you connect with other genealogical resources as well.

Learning a language? Interested in starting a new language? If so, you must try MANGO. MANGO is the library's language learning tool available through the library website. A few clicks and you are off to a foreign land, at least in your mind, as conversation tutorials guide you through the most basic to much more complex verbal exchanges in any one of dozens of languages to choose from.

Another great resource provided by the library through the website is LEARNING EXPRESS – a dynamic online learning center for children to professional level. At Learning Express Library, you will find ebooks, practice tests and tutorial courses in a wide variety of areas such as GED, college entrance, civil service, nursing, law enforcement, military, middle and elementary school skills, and more!!

Need help answering a question NOW? Go to "Ask Here PA", Pennsylvania's statewide live chat reference service. It is free to all residents of Pennsylvania, offering live chat reference 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Click the icon on the Electronic Resources page of the library website. FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE WBZH RADIO PREMIERES IN POTTSTOWN

Looking for local news, sports and information? Do you want to wake up, and see what's in store for your morning commute? What about up---to---the---minute weather information? WBZH, 1370---AM is the destination for everything you need to know to get your day started, and keep in touch with happenings in the Tri---County area.

"WPAZ had a proud history of serving Pottstown. As new owners of the station we want to take this tradition even further, by providing more coverage of everything going on in the Tri---County area", according to General Manager Rick Rodgers. "WBZH will create the buzz, and keep our neighbors up to date on important events and community resources."

"We will provide an outlet to give community organizations and individuals a voice that can be heard at 1370 AM or at www.wbzh.net on our web stream," according to Dave Devlin, News and Information Director at the station. Station Manager Ross Landy adds that "we've upgraded equipment, and invested in bringing our production facilities up to date so that we can provide production both in our offices and at remote locations, enabling us to truly bring this service to people throughout our listening area."

The station changed format and call letters at noon on Monday, October 24th. Entertainment hasn't been forgotten – music choices will include current hits, alternative and independent artists, and local voices as well. Specialty programming will remain – blues, jazz, bluegrass, country, and polka, as well as a full night of local programming on Wednesdays, Sunday morning gospel and religious programming, and the popular Paranormal Tuesday programming.

This is only Phase 2 of plans for the station, and General Manager Rick Rodgers points out that Phase 3 is already in the works. WPAZ had been an important resource in Pottstown, and WBZH takes that one step further, bringing a voice to the Tri---County area. What will Phase 3 include? Stay tuned and find out!



INSTRUCTIONS FOR
HELPING TO KEEP
YOUR
DRIVEWAY CLEAR
OF SNOW AFTER
THE
TOWNSHIP PLOWS
HAVE PASSED

- 1) Facing the street, clear an area to the left of your driveway.
- 2) As a result, all of the snow that you clear should be placed to the right of your driveway.
- 3) This cleared area will help "catch" displaced snow that would otherwise land in your driveway.
- 4) Please, note that clearing the snow to the left of your driveway will not keep all of the snow out of your driveway, but it will greatly reduce the amount that you will have to "re-shovel."
