STREETS, SIDEWALKS & SNOW

Snow Removal on Sidewalks ~ The property owner shall, within 24 hours after the cessation of any snowfall, clear at least a two-foot-wide path on any sidewalk on or abutting their property, but when the snowfall results in the accumulation of 12 or more inches of snow, then the deadline shall be extended to 48 hours after the cessation of the snowfall. In the event snow and/or ice on a sidewalk becomes so hard that it cannot be removed without likelihood of damaging the sidewalk, the owner shall cause enough sand or other abrasive to be put on the sidewalk to make travel reasonably safe, and as soon thereafter as the weather permits, the owner shall clear at least a two-foot-wide path on any sidewalk on or abutting their property.

Cul-de-Sac Parking ~ Any time our crews are called out to clear snow and ice from our roadways, residents will be required to remove their vehicles from cul-de-sacs for the duration of such snow emergencies. During declared emergencies, no vehicle will be permitted to park within the bulb of the cul-de-sac or within 25 feet of the entrance to the bulb. Thank you for helping us make a better job of clearing snow from our streets.

Clearing Snow from Your Driveway ~ Facing the street, clear an area to the left of your driveway. As a result, all of the snow that you clear should be placed to the right of your driveway. This cleared area will help "catch" plowed snow that would otherwise land in your driveway. Please note that clearing the snow to the left of your driveway will not keep all of the snow out of your driveway, but it will greatly reduce the amount that you will have to "re-shovel."

Christmas Tree Recycling Program Scheduled

Give Your Tree A Second Purpose!

GreenAllies, in cooperation with Upper Pottsgrove Township, will hold its annual Community Christmas Tree Recycling Program on Saturday, January 6th from 9 am to 4 pm, at the Althouse Arboretum, 1794 Gilbertsville Road.

The recycling day is open to everyone in the region and is free of charge, however we do request donations. Members of the public are invited to drive their trees to the Althouse Arboretum where volunteer students will assist in removing the trees. Upper Pottsgrove Township will chip the trees for use by GreenAllies as cover on the walking trails.

This community event is sponsored by GreenAllies with its mission to "Empower students to lead the community toward a more sustainable future".



Update for 2017

It has been a busy, but fruitful year at the Althouse Arboretum on Gilbertsville Road. Here is a glance at the numbers:

- Ropes course has been used ten times this past fall. The use was by eight outside contracts and two by Green Allies. More than 600 people used the exciting ropes course, learning teamwork with individual initiative.
- There were 58 sponsored programs to date, attended by 3,650 people with assistance by 323 students.
- GreenAllies data center reported more than 4,000 visited the Althouse Arboretum in 2017 to walk the trails, use the children's forest trail, or picnic.
- Althouse Arboretum has seen a 10% increase of trail users this past year, totaling 22 people, in some cases with their dogs in attendance, enjoying a leisurely walk on any given day. Interestingly, 2,552 miles have been logged in and out on our trails at the Arboretum, including the connecting use of the Township's trails along Sprogel's Run and the Prout Farm Trail.

TRASH COLLECTION RATES FOR 2018

The following solid waste and recycling services shall be the **minimum provided** to each resident in Upper Pottsgrove Township by any municipal waste/recycling collector: Trash Collection, 1 x per week; Collection of Bulk Items, 1 x per week; Collection of White Goods (The Municipal Waste Collector shall be responsible to evacuate the Freone or other coolant from White Goods in accordance with DEP requirements.), 1 x per week; Collection of Yard Waste and Leaf Waste, (Weekly, April 1 through December 15); Recycling, to include Glass - All colors • Plastics 1 -7 • Newsprint/Magazines • Aluminum, Bi-metals & Tin, 1 x per week; and Tires, 1 tire per week. 
