10 THINGS YOU CAN DO TO PREVENT STORMWATER RUNOFF POLLUTION



Residents are urged to do these things to offset negative stormwater impacts and to <u>save tax dollars</u> that would otherwise be spent on remediation.

- Use fertilizers sparingly and sweep up driveways, sidewalks, and gutters
- Never dump anything down storm drains or in streams
- Vegetate bare spots in your yard
- Compost your yard waste
- Use least toxic pesticides, follow labels, and learn how to prevent pest problems
- Direct downspouts away from paved surfaces; consider a rain garden to capture runoff
- Take your car to the car wash or wash it on your lawn instead of washing it in the driveway Check your car for leaks and recycle your motor oil
- Pick up after your pet
- Have your septic tank pumped and system inspected regularly


