**ON YOUR PARK GET SET, GO!
VOTE FOR HOLLENBACH PARK**

In an effort to continue building a healthy community and to inspire people to get back to the many area parks, Pottstown Health and Wellness is introducing their second annual campaign to support area parks. When people in our community "get active" on behalf of their favorite local park, it could mean helping their park win money for improvements.

When people come to our park, they can vote for it to be named one of the winners. The overall winner and top vote-getter will receive a \$10,000 recreation grant. The first runner-up will receive \$7,500. The second runner-up will receive \$5,000. The rest of the participating parks will be entered into a lottery resulting in an additional winner of \$2,500. The contest will run from July 1 through July 31, 2015.

Ways to Vote

During the course of the competition, there are four specific methods to accumulate votes for a park:

1. Scanning a QR Code (located on signs displayed in Hollenbach Park)
2. Taking a selfie photograph and uploading it to the Mission Healthy Living Facebook page (Facebook.com/MissionHealthyU) or emailing the photo to OnYourPark@gmail.com
3. Voting online on the Mission Healthy Living Facebook page (Facebook.com/MissionHealthyU)
4. Water Bottles: Scan the QR code on the bottle and enter the code on the cap.

Votes from QR codes and Facebook are tabulated in real time, allowing users to see where his or her favorite park stands in the rankings.




Upper Pottsgrove Township residents with a property assessed at \$100,000 pay \$377 per year for: Police protection, road maintenance, administrative services and fire protection.

HOW TO FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE TOWNSHIP

To file a complaint with the Township, please contact the administrative office at (610) 323-8675 or at administration@uptownship.org and:

Give a brief description of the problem.

Give your name, address and phone number.

The administrative staff will then relay your complaint to the appropriate entity, either the Public Works Department, the Police Department, the Township Manager or the Township Engineer. All personal information provided is kept strictly confidential, however, the Township will do nothing with anonymous complaints.
