NEW BUSINESS

A. **Discuss mowing classification proposal** ~ Used N. Coventry as a template which M. Lane customized the plan for Upper Pottsgrove Township.

GC – No mowing needed @ Hollenbach triangle piece & Hoffman field. SW – Recommended changing the mowing plan to be reviewed by the manager periodically in paragraph 2 and the frequency be at the discretion of the Township Manager in paragraph 6. GC recommended a motion to adopt this proposal (with the changes) to the BOC for approval. Motion by S. Wagner, second by D. Elliot.

- B. **Discuss hayfield proposal** ~ Members agreed to hold in reserve & will use if needed but would rather speak with farmers directly if they are interested. All agreed to remove the last paragraph on the plan and add the hayfield plan will be reviewed annually by the Township Manager.
- C. *Discuss timetable for Michael Lane punch list for Sunset Park* ~ complete repairs within 30 days of notice with no extension.
- D. **Discuss possible reopening ceremony for Sunset Park** ~ all agreed to put on the website and Facebook that it's opened and possibly a sign. D. Elliot recommended cleaning up the pond.
- E. **Discuss repairs requested by OSR Board** ~ G. Churach presented a list of repairs needed at Goose Run, Fox Hill, and Sunset Parks. He also suggested other members to email him when they see things that need to be fixed so he can get them on the repair list for the next meeting.
- F. Discuss equestrian use on trails ~ M. Reddick reported she rec'd a complaint of horses being ridden on the trails and horse poop being left behind. G. Churach mentioned that the trails aren't wide enough & there's no such thing as a poop bag for horses. G. Churach asked M. Reddick, the next time she receives another citizen's request to get more information about where the horses are coming from. The board agreed to hold off unless the situation arises again. If we need to send any letters to local residents with horses we may do so in the future.

B. Status of farming plot applicants ~ we've only been contacted by one farmer at this point.

C. Status of Gilbertsville Road crossing ~ J. Bean and S. Griffith are working on this. *D. Status of Fox Hill trail easement survey* ~ M. Reddick is in the process of obtaining a survey of Fox Hill Trail.

E. Update on Pottsgrove Inclusive Playground ~ Went Public on Playground. *F. PARRC reports* ~ C. Paretti provided a Planner Report, Explanation of Pie Chart (Mike Lane), Strategic Plan, and the PARRC Report to OS&R below:
