The regular meeting of the Upper Pottsgrove Township Sewer & Water Committee meeting was held on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. Committee members in attendance were Chairman John Bealer, Dave Crock and Township Engineer Christopher Pelka.

<u>Pledge of Allegiance</u> – Those in attendance pledged allegiance to the flag.

Public Comment – None.

Approval of Minutes – Approval of the minutes of the January 2, 2018 meeting were tabled.

<u>Engineer's Report</u> – <u>Flows</u> – Flows have been good but February and March will be high. <u>Poplar Meter</u> – Pottstown Borough Authority has been notified but it is doubtful that this will be a high priority. We may need to appeal recorded flow volumes. This was also mentioned at the Joint Sewer Meeting on March 8, 2018.

<u>Regal Oaks Pump Station and Pineford Pump Station</u> – Currently there is no method to measure flows outside of run time at max gpm. ROPS cannot use an SD Card; therefore more extensive upgrades would be necessary. Justin Bean is acquiring cost estimates.

<u>Regal Oaks I & I</u> – Field observation of Manholes R4A and R6A on Friday, March 2 during high level rain event revealed potential problem with water entering the manholes through annular space between clay pipe and the liner. MH R3B previously observed to have I & I above the outlet pipe. These repairs should be a priority. Chris Pelka will get information on cost estimates and further inspections.

<u>North Hanover Street Lining Project</u> – Flows still spike with heavy rain. Further investigation of laterals and cleanout repairs need to be undertaken.

<u>Cherrytree Farms</u> – Multiple cleanout caps observed to be broken. Letters should be sent to the homeowners for repair. The Board discussed the Municipality possibly replacing caps. <u>Sprogel's Run</u> – Testing of sewer lines and manholes has been partially completed. The farmette sewer lateral will be installed after successful testing. Phase I sanitary installation has been completed.

<u>DVDC Development</u> – Construction has begun. Sanitary sewer has been installed across Moyer Road this week. It will continue up Cross Road pending the weather. 2018 CFA Small Sewer and Water Grant Program – The application has been submitted. A public meeting will be set up in the future.

<u>MS4</u> – All storm water infrastructure mapping is being significantly updated into the GIS system. New permits are still scheduled for release in March 2018.

<u>Adjournment</u> – The Board adjourned the meeting at 6:50 p.m. by unanimous consent of those present.
