 - 5. “Trail closed from sunset to sunup” signs have been installed on the trail along Snyder Road.

 - 7. Received a \$15,000 grant for the trail study from PAH&W Foundation. The Commissioners have committed to providing the remaining \$20,000 to complete the study, but we are hopeful more grant money can be found.
